National Food Safety Authority The Authority's Board Resolution No. 3 of the year 2020

Board Chairman,

After Preamble,



RESOLVED THE FOLLOWING:

Article (1)

In application of the principles of hazard analysis and determination of the control activities on foods in light of their hazard degrees, it shall be sufficient to inspect a portion of 25% of the food raw materials consignments (factory production requisites) imported on account of the requirements cards to factories or the industrial requisites imported on account of the investment card to factories, as regards the factories approved by the National Food Safety Authority (the whitelist).

Article (2)

In application of the principles of hazard analysis and determination of the control activities on foods in light of their hazard degrees, it shall be sufficient to inspect a portion of 25% of the fully-processed foodstuffs subject to the National Food Safety Authority's board resolution No. 2 of the year 2020, which are inspected before shipment, provided they shall be accompanied by an approved inspection certificate issued by the inspection and conformity companies registered with the National Food Safety Authority.

Article (3)

The Authority's board chairman shall issue the controls regulating the enforcement of the present resolution, and shall have the right to modify the inspection percentage in such a manner as to suit any changes that may occur.

The stipulations of the present resolution shall be enforced as of the day following its date of publication in Al-Wakaye Al-Mesreya/Government Bulletin, and shall remain in force till the end of May, 2020.
